**Monday, May 12 - Ss. Nereus, Achilleus, Domitilla, Virgin, & Pancras, Martyrs, III Class, Red**

Nereus and Achilleus, soldiers of the Roman army, converted to the Faith and were beheaded. The Roman virgin Domitilla died in exile. Tradition holds Pancras to have been martyred at 14 years of age for refusing to sacrifice to idols. Traditionally on Low Sunday, the children of Rome would go to renew their baptismal promises at his tomb.

**Tuesday, May 13 - St. Robert Bellarmine, Bishop, Confessor & Doctor, III Class, White**

St. Robert rendered special service to the Popes in the years following the Council of Trent. By his controversial books he dealt formidable blows to Protestantism, while by his catechism, translated into forty languages, he spread the knowledge of the Catholic faith in all countries of the world. He died on September 17, 1621 and was canonized by Pius XI in 1930.

### Sacraments at Mater Dei

**For Mater Dei Parishioners who have been registered and active (Sunday Mass attending) for at least one year.**

**Baptism** - Please allow 1 month's notice for the Sacrament of Baptism. For more information, please email the office.

**First Holy Communion** - There is a two-year formation period which begins at the time of registration. Children must be minimally age 7 and in 2nd grade by the age of reception. Parents may choose to catechize their child at home, or enroll him/her in the parish First Confession/ Communion catechism class. *\* A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration.*

**Confirmation** - Youth (7th - 12th grade): There is a two-year formation period. Registration will begin in the summer. Adults: Email the office for more information. A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration.

**Marriage** - Contact the parish office to meet with one of the parish priests a minimum of six months prior to proposed date; preparation program required. Either the bride or groom must have a domicile in the Dallas Diocese and be a parishioner at Mater Dei in order to have a wedding ceremony at the parish.

**Reception of the Sacraments can't be guaranteed for those who reside outside of the Dallas Diocese.**
