Nereus and Achilleus, soldiers of the Roman army, converted to the Faith and were beheaded. The Roman virgin Domitilla died in exile. Tradition holds Pancras to have been martyred at 14 years of age for refusing to sacrifice to idols. Tuesday, May 13 - St. Robert Bellarmine, Bishop, Confessor & Doctor, III Class, White

St. Robert rendered special service to the Popes in the years following the Council of Trent. By his controversial books he dealt formidable blows to Protestantism, while by his catechism, translated into forty languages, he spread the knowledge of the Catholic faith in all countries of the world. 
