Monday, May 26 - St. Philip Neri, *Confessor*, III Class, White

Born in Florence in 1515, St. Phillip Neri lived all his life in Rome and was one of the most influential persons of his time. After living as a pilgrim or hermit for 15 years in the streets of Rome, he was ordained a priest at 36 years of age and gathered around himself a group of twenty priests who formed a congregation of secular priests of the Oratory. But St. Phillip's life remained what it always had been, original in character and a very great influence for holiness, which seemed to radiate from him. He died in 1595.

Tuesday, May 27 - St. Bede the Venerable, *Confessor & Doctor*, III Class, White

Born at Jarrow in Northumberland, England, Bede would become a Benedictine monk and was noted as "the most observant and happiest of all monks." One of the most learned churchmen of his time, he wrote very full commentaries on Sacred Scripture. Pope Leo XIII declared him a Doctor of the Church. St. Bede died on May 25, 735.

Sacraments at Mater Dei

For Mater Dei Parishioners who have been registered and active (Sunday Mass attending) for at least one year.

Baptism - Please allow 1 month’s notice for the Sacrament of Baptism. For more information, please email the office.

First Holy Communion - There is a two-year formation period which begins at the time of registration. Children must be minimally age 7 and in 2nd grade by the age of reception. Parents may choose to catechize their child at home, or enroll him/her in the parish First Confession/ Communion catechism class. ** A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration.*

Confirmation - Youth (7th – 12th grade): There is a two-year formation period. Registration will begin in the summer. Adults: Email the office for more information. A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration.

Marriage - Contact the parish office to meet with one of the parish priests a minimum of six months prior to proposed date; preparation program required. Either the bride or groom must have a domicile in the Dallas Diocese and be a parishioner at Mater Dei in order to have a wedding ceremony at the parish.

Reception of the Sacraments can’t be guaranteed for those who reside outside of the Dallas Diocese.
