He was a poet as well as a commentator on Sacred Scripture, and composed hymns about the mysteries of Christ, our Lady, and the saints; he was called the 'harp of the Holy Spirit." For the feast of Corpus Christi, the Church has chosen the Thursday between the Sunday on which she speaks of God's mercy towards men and the consequent duty of fraternal charity among Christians and the second Sunday after Pentecost when she resumes the same thread of thought in the Epistle and presents in the Gospel the Kingdom of Heaven in the form of the parable of the Supper. Both the Office and Mass for the feast were composed by St. Thomas Aquinas. In them are found an expression of the very soul of the saint together with the doctrinal accuracy of the great Theologian.


