Born in France on November 14, 1601, he would found the Congregation of Jesus and Mary in 1643 and the Congregation of the Sisters of Charity of Our Lady in 1644. Renowned as a preacher and ascetic writer, he promoted the public worship of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. He died August 19, 1690 and canonized in 1925.

Wednesday, August 20 - St. Bernard of Clairvaux, Abbot & Doctor, III Class, White

Born in 1090, he founded a monasteries at Citeaux and Clairvaux under the Cisterian discipline, a form of Benedictines. An austere monk, a great orator, and learned doctor, his teaching enlightened Europe in the twelfth century. Pope Eugenius III received his monastic training from St. Bernard and sought his counsel through his pontificate. A staunch defender of the faith against heresy, St. Bernard preached the second crusade against Islam. He died in 1153.

Thursday, August 21 - St. Jane Frances de Chantal, III Class, White

The mother of four children and widowed at the age of 28, under the kindly but firm direction of St. Francis de Sales, she freed herself from everything that could hold her affection to the world in order to devote herself entirely to God. In her burning love for God, she found the strength to separate herself from her children and founded the Order of Visitation. She died in 1641.



Sacraments at Mater Dei

For Mater Dei Parishioners who have been registered and active (Sunday Mass attending) for at least one year.

Baptism - Please allow 1 month's notice for the Sacrament of Baptism. For more information, please email the office.

<u>First Holy Communion</u> - There is a two-year formation period which begins at the time of registration. Children must be minimally age 7 and in 2nd grade by the age of reception. Parents may choose to catechize their child at home, or enroll him/her in the parish First Confession/ Communion catechism class. * A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration.

Confirmation - Youth (7th – 12th grade): There is a two-year formation period. Registration will begin in the summer. Adults: Email the office for more information. A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration.

Marriage - Contact the parish office to meet with one of the parish priests a minimum of six months prior to proposed date; preparation program required. Either the bride or groom must have a domicile in the Dallas Diocese and be a parishioner at Mater Dei in order to have a wedding ceremony at the parish.

Reception of the Sacraments can't be guaranteed for those who reside outside of the Dallas Diocese.
