**Tuesday, May 5 - St. Pius V, Pope & Confessor, III Class, White**

One of the most illustrious popes of Church history, St. Pius concluded the Council of Trent and applied the decrees of the Council for the reform of the Church. He ended the Muslim threat to the Christian West with the decisive victory at Lepanto, obtained by our Lady's intercession through the Rosary. He played a great part in the restoration of the clergy to ecclesiastical discipline and standardized the liturgical books of the Roman rite.

## Sacraments at Mater Dei

**For Mater Dei Parishioners who have been registered and active (Sunday Mass attending) for at least 6 months.**

**Baptism** - Please allow 1 month's notice for the Sacrament of Baptism. For more information, please email the office.

**First Holy Communion** - There is a two-year formation period which begins at the time of registration. Children must be minimally age 7 and in 2nd grade by the age of reception. Parents may choose to catechize their child at home, or enroll him/her in the parish First Confession/ Communion catechism class. \* **A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration.**

**Confirmation** - Youth (7th – 12th grade): There is a two-year formation period. Registration will begin in the summer. Adults: Email the office for more information. A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration.

**Marriage** - Contact the parish office to meet with one of the parish priests a minimum of six months prior to proposed date; preparation program required. Either the bride or groom must have a domicile in the Dallas Diocese and be a parishioner at Mater Dei in order to have a wedding ceremony at the parish.

**Reception of the Sacraments can't be guaranteed for those who reside outside of the Dallas Diocese.**
