Friday, June 12 - Sacred Heart of Jesus, I Class, White

In the sixteenth century Protestantism, and in the seventeenth Jansenism, attempted to distort one of the essential truths of Christianity, namely, the love of God for all men. The liturgy, which is the living expression of the Faith of the Church, countered these attempts by the institution of the feast of the Sacred Heart which proclaims and exalts the universal and infinite love of our Savior. The feast day falls on the Friday after the traditional octave of Corpus Christi; after having celebrated the mystery of the Holy Eucharist for eight days, the Church now honors the Sacred Heart, the incarnation through our Lord's Sacred Humanity of the very love of God.

Saturday, June 13 - St. Anthony of Padua, Confessor & Doctor, III Class, White

Born in Lisbon, Portugal, in 1196, he eventually became a Franciscan and preached throughout Portugal and Italy. Both as a theologian and preacher he fought vigorously against heresy. His preaching was inspired by a love of God and of souls and had an extraordinary power of conviction; it was filled with the penetrating power of Sacred Scripture, so much so that Pope Gregory IX hailed him a "living repository of Sacred Scripture." He died in Padua in 1231 with a reputation of great sanctity.

Sacraments at Mater Dei

For Mater Dei Parishioners who have been registered and active (Sunday Mass attending) for at least 6 months.

Baptism - Please allow 1 month's notice for the Sacrament of Baptism. For more information, please email the office.

First Holy Communion - There is a two-year formation period which begins at the time of registration. Children must be minimally age 7 and in 2nd grade by the age of reception. Parents may choose to catechize their child at home, or enroll him/her in the parish First Confession/ Communion catechism class. * **A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration.**

Confirmation - Youth (7th - 12th grade): There is a two-year formation period. Registration will begin in the summer. Adults: Email the office for more information. A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration.

Marriage - Contact the parish office to meet with one of the parish priests a minimum of six months prior to proposed date; preparation program required. Either the bride or groom must have a domicile in the Dallas Diocese and be a parishioner at Mater Dei in order to have a wedding ceremony at the parish.

Reception of the Sacraments can't be guaranteed for those who reside outside of the Dallas Diocese.
