Twice in the course of the year the Church celebrates our Lord's Transfiguration on Mount Thabor – on the second Sunday of Lernt in order to bear witness to His divinity as His Passion draws near, and again today to celebrate His exaltation in glory. Pope Callistus III ordered the observance of this feast for the entire Church on August 6 to commemorate the victory over the Muslim Turks near Belgrade in 1456, which was announced in Rome on this day.

Born near Lyons, France in 1786, ordained in August 1815, St. John Vianney was parish priest at Ars for nearly 42 years. His simple preaching touched the hearts of both young and old. Crowds flocked to the holy priest, who sat some days up to 16 hours in the confessional. Through his prayers, penances, and long years as pastor, he managed to revitalize a parish that had been morally and spiritually corrupt when he took over. He died in 1859.

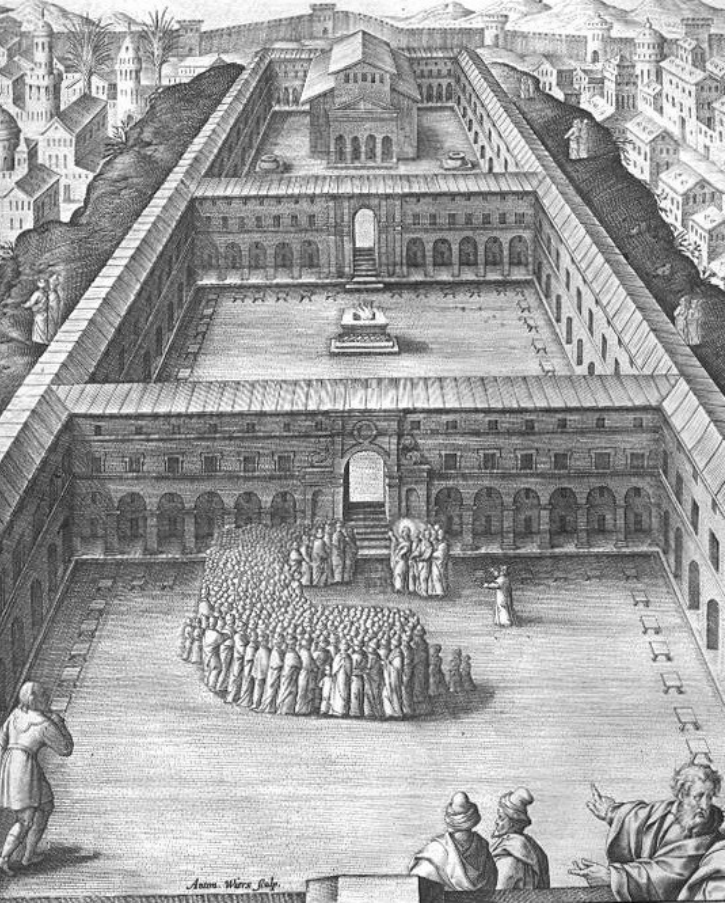

Small Children Receiving Communion

Out of reverence and safety for the Blessed Sacrament, the priests ask that if your child while kneeling at the Communion Rail is too short, ie, their chin is not over the Communion Rail, they stand on the kneeler to receive Communion. This allows the altar boy to place the Communion plate under his/her chin, ready to catch the Host if It should fall.

Persons Requesting Assistance on Parish Property

If you encounter someone on parish property requesting money or other assistance, please notify a member of the Safety Team rather than handling the situation yourself. If no Safety Team member is available, you may provide the person with the St. Vincent de Paul Conference Help Line number (469-248-8507) for possible, non-immediate assistance. For everyone's safety and well-being, parishioners are asked not to provide cash, offer transportation, or invite the person into nonpublic areas of the parish. If anyone appears to need immediate medical attention, presents an immediate danger, or there is another emergency, call 911 and notify the Safety Team.

Sacraments at Mater Dei

For Mater Dei Parishioners who have been registered and active (Sunday Mass attending) for at least 6 months.

Baptism - Please allow 1 month’s notice for the Sacrament of Baptism. For more information, please email the office.

First Holy Communion - There is a two-year formation period which begins at the time of registration. Children must be minimally age 7 and in 2nd grade by the age of reception. Parents may choose to catechize their child at home, or enroll him/her in the parish First Confession/ Communion catechism class. ** A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration.*

Confirmation - Youth (7th – 12th grade): There is a two-year formation period. Registration will begin in the summer. Adults: Email the office for more information. A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration.

Marriage - Contact the parish office to meet with one of the parish priests a minimum of six months prior to proposed date; preparation program required. Either the bride or groom must have a domicile in the Dallas Diocese and be a parishioner at Mater Dei in order to have a wedding ceremony at the parish.

Reception of the Sacraments can’t be guaranteed for those who reside outside of the Dallas Diocese.

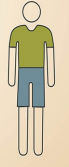
